



IIM Indore Integrated Diploma in Management Program Entrance Test Analysis

IIM Indore has announced the start of its first batch of Integrated Diploma in Management, a 5-year program for students passing out of class XII.

The entrance test was held on 25th September 2011 at six locations.

Total Number of Students for AT and PI: 1041

Total Number of students at Delhi: 513

The personal Interview for all the candidates will be held from 26th Sep to 28th September 2011.

Section Wise Analysis:

There were three sections in the paper with 50 questions, which were of 200 marks in total. 4 marks were awarded for every correct answer and 1 mark was deducted for every incorrect answer.

Verbal Ability:

The VA section had 20 questions based on Reading comprehension and Grammar. There were two sets of Reading Comprehension Questions with three questions each. This section also had questions on Para jumbles, Sentence Completion etc. Overall, the section was of moderate difficulty level. It was possible to attempt all the questions and one can easily get about 14-15 questions correct in this section.

Quantitative Aptitude:

The quantitative aptitude section also had 20 questions. This section was of moderate difficulty level. It was possible to get about 15 questions correct in this section.

General Awareness:

The general awareness section focused on current affairs and had 10 questions. This section must have seemed easy to anyone with a habit of newspaper reading.

8. India is not a part of :OPEC, SAARC, Common wealth?
9. Jasmine Revolution

The level of difficulty of the paper was moderate and this means that PI will play a very important role in the selection process.
