

SET BBA 2011: Analysis

Symbiosis Entrance for BBA had nothing new this year. Like last year, the questions were quite easy this year.

The examination comprised 150 questions. The test was divided equally over the five sections. This year too, the examination was on similar lines as those of the last year.

The time limit was 150 mins.

Total number of questions was 150 and 4 options of each question.

The overall difficulty level of the paper was moderate.

The overall break up of the paper was as follows:

The section-wise analysis of the paper:

General English:

A total of 40 questions were asked under this section. The overall difficulty level of the questions ranged from easy to moderate. The questions were easy to solve. An average student must be able to attempt at least 30+ questions in the section.

Major part of this section was devoted to vocabulary. There was just one passage and only 4 questions based on that. In a way, Reading Comprehension part was almost missing.

Quantitative Aptitude:

A total of 40 questions were asked under this section. The overall difficulty level of the questions ranged from easy to moderate. An average student must be able to attempt at least 30+ questions in this section. Anyone who worked on the basics of elementary mathematics would be able to score decent marks in this section.

Analytical and Logical Reasoning:

This section seemed to be quite easy with 30 questions in total. The questions were easier and any student, who have attended regular classes and gone through the CL study material, will find it easier to score in this section. Questions related to Sequence and Series, Blood Relations, arrangements, directions etc and were easy to attempt.

General Knowledge:

This year's SET 2011 examination had 40 GK questions out of a total of 150 questions, thus having a weight age of nearly 25%, which is quite significant. Majority of the questions were from Static part of General knowledge with some Current GK questions. The level of difficulty of the paper was moderate. A score in the range of 27 to 30 can be considered as good score. Modern history was given due importance this time. Some questions were really testing...like TINA and what took you so long...

Last, but definitely not the least, the **expected cut-off**: it can be safely **estimated** that it would hover around **105** (tentative) as it seemed similar to last year's paper.
