

IRMA Results ANALYSIS

The results of IRMA written test for PRM 2010-12 is already declared. In the brochure of IRMA, it was clearly mentioned that what would be the cut – off marks for each section as well as the overall cut – off marks. Our analysis of the IRMA test was based on what was mentioned in the IRMA brochure. But what they meant by “*Cut – Off*” in the brochure was probably the “*Qualifying marks*” that must be obtained in each section as well as overall. The actual cut – off marks in the examination were as follows:

In the above table, at the same marks, the corresponding percentiles are different. For example at 132 marks, the corresponding percentiles are 98.72 and 98.69. This is because the marks obtained in each section are in integers. Obviously, the marks in some cases have been rounded off to the next higher integer. But the percentiles have been calculated on the actual score. For example, though the actual marks of two students obtaining 77.25 and 77.75 would be 78, but their percentiles would be different.
