

ATMA-Feb 2010

The pattern of ATMA of February 2010 was very similar to the pattern followed in the previous years. The bird's eye view of the paper is as follows: the paper was divided into six sections and 30 minutes were allotted for each section. A student appearing for the test had to devote 30 minutes to a particular section and he/she was not allowed to skip the sections. There were two distinct sections each of quantitative skills, analytical reasoning skills and verbal skills.

One notable observation of the test was that there were 2-3 apparent errors in each of the sections.

Overall difficulty level of the Verbal Skills section was easy to moderate. The questions followed more or less the same pattern as has been followed in the previous years. There were questions on reading comprehension (three RCs), vocabulary (synonym or antonym pair), grammar, proper usage of words, sentence completion, critical reasoning questions (identify the assumption, sentence following, sentence preceding etc.) and para-jumble questions. Most of the questions tested the basics of the English language.

In quantitative skills section the paper was evenly distributed across the various topics. Majority of the questions were on arithmetic, geometry and modern mathematics. The overall difficulty level was easy to moderate.

In analytical reasoning section, the questions were based on circular arrangement, two dimensional array, coding decoding, data-sufficiency, decision making questions and input-output relations.
